 $\ensuremath{ \text{HPS}^+}$ is an interdisciplinary and international study programme.


HPS⁺ is open for graduates from the humanities, the natural sciences and the social sciences.

The **first year** of the study programme focuses on the extension and consolidation of philosophical, historical and cultural knowledge of the sciences and the humanities. You will amplify your previous knowledge and expand your basic skills.

The **second year** provides opportunities for indepth studies and specialisation. You will deepen your gained knowledge and develop your competences in scientific methods.



You may choose to pursue in-depth research or to collect hands-on experience in a practice-oriented project.

You will develop your social and communication skills for your future job in academia or beyond.

CURRICULUM OF THE PROGRAMME

Semester 1 & 2

Three compulsory modules + three out of four elective modules
 (each semester 30 CP / 12 hours per week)

Semester 3

- Research module (30 CP / 10 hours per week)or
- Praxis module for a work experience (30 CP / 3 months)

Semester 4

- Concluding colloquium (6 CP / 2 hours per week)
- Master thesis(24 CP / 4 months)
